## PRESCRIPTION COPAYS:

### Retail Pharmacy

#### 30 Day Supply

Generic Drugs:	\$7
Brand Name Drugs:	25% Minimum of \$20 Maximum of \$100
Non-Preferred Drugs:	35% Minimum of \$35 Maximum of \$125

### Mail Order Pharmacy

#### 90 Day Supply

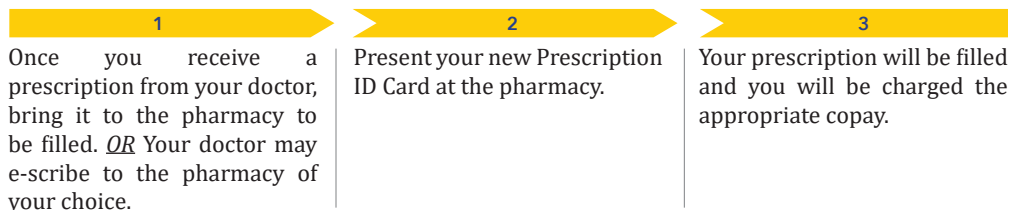
Generic Drugs:	\$7
Brand Name Drugs:	\$20
Non-Preferred Drugs:	\$40

### Specialty Pharmacy

#### 30 Day Supply Limit

Generic Drugs:	\$7
Brand Name Drugs:	20% up to \$100
Non-Preferred Drugs:	20% up to \$100

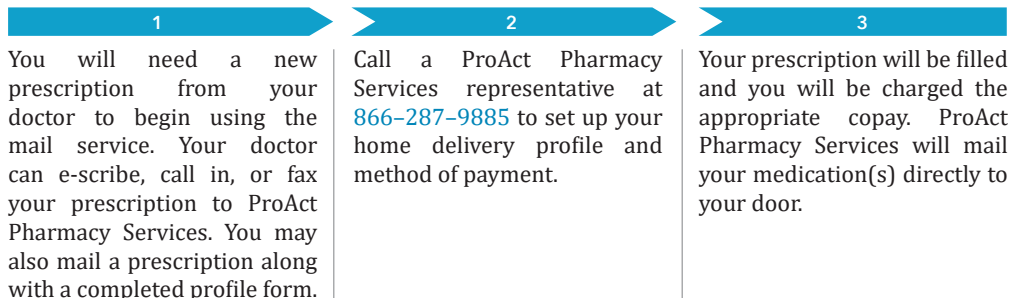
## RETAIL PHARMACY:

- Finding in-network pharmacies based on your zip code is easy with the Pharmacy Finder tool on [www.ProActRx.com](http://www.ProActRx.com).

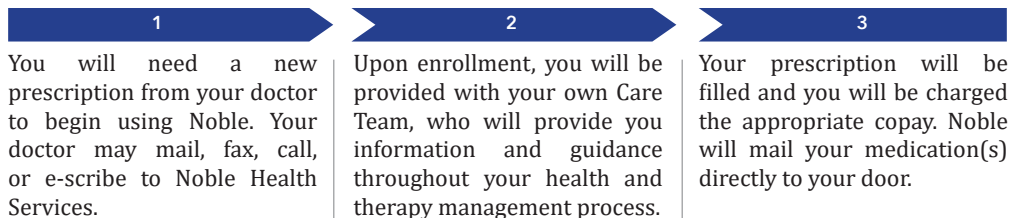
## MAIL ORDER PHARMACY:
